### 3 Questions With a CSI Employee - Tony Force, Metal Shop 19 Supervisor

- 1. Can you describe the metal shop and some of the items you make? The Metal Shop is a fabrication welding and paint shop. Our main customer is the NE Game and Parks. We build all the picnic tables and four different types of grills, ranging from a small pedestal grill to a larger pedestal grill. There is a ground grill and a large grill with or without a pedestal. The large grill is around 360 pounds when built. We manufacture bunkbeds for the institutions. We also make the tables in the yard and some are placed in the units.
- 2. What is something most people do not know about the Metal Shop? The Metal Shop is the only fabrication shop at CSI. Based off material size due to older machines, we can build about anything you want if it is 10 gage and smaller. All shops call me when they need something made or fixed out of metal. Even the maintenance crew at NSP has had us fix or fabricate parts for them.
- 3. How long does it take to make the most complicated item? What is it? I would say that the school desks with tops are the hardest most intricate item we build. It would take around a week to build the old-school desks from start to finish. That is without paint as the last time we made these they were sent out for powder coating.
