


## LIQUID BLEACH

# DIRECTIONS LAUNDRY USE:

Standard washer, 1 cup bleach; extra large washer, 1 1/2 cups bleach. If uncertain about dye colorfastness, test fabric by applying one drop of solution made of one tablespoon bleach plus 1/4 cup of water to a hidden part of seam. Be sure to check all colors. After one minute blot dry. No color change means the article can be safely bleached. Avoid bleaching wool, silk, mohair, leather, spandex and non-fast colors.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store bleach in a cool, dry place. Do not reuse empty container. Instead, rinse and put in trash collection.



### Danger

Causes severe skin burns and eye damage.
Causes serious eye damage.

**Prevention:** Wash face, hands and any exposed skin thoroughly after handling. Wear protective gloves, protective clothing, face protection, and eye protection such as safety glasses.

Response: Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor. IF SWAL-LOWED: Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. IF ON SKIN (or hair): Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water/shower. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. IF INHALED: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. IF IN

**EYES:** Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.

Storage: Store locked up.

**Disposal:** Dispose of contents in accordance with all applicable federal, state, and local regulations.

Hazards not otherwise classified (HNOC): Although not expected, heart conditions or chronic respiratory problems such as asthma, chronic bronchitis, or obstructive lung disease may be aggravated by exposure to high concentrations of vapor or mist.

Product contains a strong oxidizer. Always flush drains before and after use.
